Review: FAMILIA @ THE KEY, SATURDAY 12TH AUGUST

After several successive weekends of festivals and sunshine, dodging raindrops on the way to King's Cross feels like a thrillingly, authentically London night out. Fields are nice and all that, but for a real clubbing kick it's got to be dark and sweaty. It's good to be back in the intimate confines of The Key, drinking vodka tonics from proper glasses, watching people wobble between sofas and the dancefloor. A bi-monthly party, Familia operate a stripped down music policy in every sense of the word: tonight's entertainment in two rooms is split between just four DJs.

The upstairs is filling up dizzyingly quick, as ex-Turnmills DJ competition finalist Dave Brazewell puts on a mini-tutorial in warm-up DJing. Keep it deep and chunky, or bouncy and funky, mix it up, remember you're playing for them, not you. His efforts have the top floor swarming, girls in dangerous looking stilettos playfully grinding

with boys in flat caps, that sort of thing.

Only the promise of Steve Bug lures us away. Downstairs there are fewer girls in heels, but the flat-cap posse has multiplied. One, in front of me, seems to be having trouble controlling his arms. His hands keep shooting into the air at any opportunity. It's difficult to exactly classify what Steve is playing – not house, not pure techno, certainly not "minimal". Just solid, driving, 4/4 electronic sounds that have the crowd climbing over themselves to get nearer the DJ booth. The deck maestro is small and serious-looking, but he seems to have established an easy camaraderie with the dancefloor – peeking up from time to time to gauge the effect of his mixing. The Germans score again!

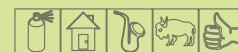
